<p>Chris Rochfort (WSP) contacted Steve Wilcock and Rob Jarman (MBC) to consult over potential lighting issues associated with the proposed Kent International Gateway development near Maidstone.</p> <p>MBC were queried for any specific comments they would have on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the methodology proposed for the lighting assessment; • any specific local authority design criteria to be followed for external lighting; and • any other guidance that should be considered. <p>MBC commented that they did not have any specific lighting guidance (e.g. supplementary planning guidance) or design criteria that should be followed for developments in the Borough, and directed WSP to conform to best practice and refer to standard guidance that should be followed as part of the lighting design. This included the Institute of Lighting Engineers (ILE) Guidance Notes for the Reduction of Obtrusive Light (2005) and other relevant guidance and criteria for lighting (e.g. DEFRA and BS guidance).</p>
