On 19th December 2008 Maidstone Borough Council adopted the Loose Road Character Area Assessment Supplementary Planning Document and the London Road Character Area Assessment Supplementary Planning Document. The documents identify the locally distinctive features that define the character of the Loose Road and London Road areas.

The adopted Supplementary Planning Documents, together with the main issues raised during the public consultations on the draft documents and the Council's response to these, can be viewed and downloaded from the Local Development Framework area of the Council's website www.maidstone.gov.uk.

The documents can also be inspected at and obtained from the Council's Reception at Maidstone Gateway, King Street, Maidstone, Kent ME15 6JQ. The Gateway is open Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday 8.30am to 5.30pm, Thursday 8.30am to 8.00pm and Saturday 9.00am to 1.00pm.

Copies are also available for inspection at all libraries within the Maidstone area during normal opening hours.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the Supplementary Planning Documents may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 19th March 2009.
