Succeeded against barriers including injury, disability, family circumstances and financial costs.

Disability Sports Award

Succeeded in sport at a national or international level. Made considerable improvements in their ability. Role model for others and have raised the profile of their sport.

Continues to implement new initiatives to further the club and serve the community. Working towards or has achieved Clubmark or national sporting equivalent. Commitment to effective recruitment, recognition and training. Have a junior and senior section.
